<b>Hutton Ridge Shiraz Cinsaut 2012</b> (South Africa) Lustrous red, giving ripe berries and a follow through of juicy well - structured, smooth finish. Great with red meats. 14%			
<b>Fortress Hill Shiraz 2009</b> (Stellenbosch, South Africa) Ruby red in colour, berry like with smoky nuances and a touch of tobacco with spicy vanilla undertones for a lingering finish. Very pleasant all rounder & we love it. 14%	Medium 175ml £4.95	Large 250ml £6.45	£18.25
<b>Fortress Hill Merlot 2010</b> (Stellenbosch, South Africa) Full flavours of red and black berries. Well balanced on the palate, with soft woody nuances in the background, for a memorable finish. 14%	Medium 175ml £4.95	Large 250ml £6.45	£18.25
<b>Rioja Carlos Serres 2011</b> (Rioja, Spain) This is a youthful tempranillo with violet rim and fresh, red & black fruit combined with liquorice and floral notes. Fresh and fruity but intense and very moreish! 13.5%		—	£19.50
<b>Meerendal Merlot 2008</b> (Stellenbosch, South Africa) A compellingly elegant example of this noble variety, showing layers of ripe blackcurrants with hints of cedar and walnuts. A balanced wine with fruit, spice and tobacco flavours. This wine displays a smooth finish and a long lasting after taste. It's utterly glorious! 14.5%		—	£29.95
<b>Chateauneuf du Pape 2010</b> (France) The legendary, full bodied, spicy wine that has to be tasted to be believed. Ideal with meats or good cheese, but just as good on its own to be savoured with friends to remember the good things in life. <b>Saint Emilion Grand Cru, Chateau Fonrazade 2008</b> (France) The vineyards of Château Fonrazade spread over 13 hectares and are among the largest in Saint Emilion. The vines are hand picked and the wine is barrel aged for 12 to 18 months. Made with great finesse it has aromas of fruit and vanilla. Perfectly balanced with supple tannins and a superb finish.
