Le Grand Duc Colombard 2012 (France)

A powerful aromatic nose of white fruits (peach, citrus and grapefruit).
Lovely and fresh in the mouth this wine is excellent as an aperitif
but also superb with salad and white meats. 13%

Flat Roof Manor Pinot Grigio 2012

Medium 175ml £4.75 Large 250ml £6.25 £17.50

(Stellenbosch, South Africa)

Dried peach and apricot with a hint of litchi.

With the emphasis on the fruit, the flavours on the nose
carry through on the palate. Delicious with light salads and cold meats.

Fortress Hill Sauvignon Blanc 2012

Medium 175ml £4.95 Large 250ml £6.45 £18.25

(Stellenbosch, South Africa)

A delicate fruity wine, with a crisp and refreshing dimension.
Well balanced with mouth watering gooseberry and tropical
fruit flavours. An ideal accompaniment to fish and white meat dishes.

Thomas Schmitt Private Collection 2007 (Germany)

Spätlese. Called a Late Harvest wine, it means the grapes are only picked
once they are completely frozen over by the first frosts of winter. This seals
the incredible sumptuous flavour of the 100% Riesling grapes, providing
wonderful liveliness and freshness and complexity. Good firm acidity with
an aromatic and lengthy finish. Perfect with pork and other white meat,
such as chicken and of course any fish.

Gribble Bridge Ortega Dry 2012 (Biddenden Kent)

more subtle and rewards you with a clean, crisp finish 11.5%

Stanley Estates Sauvignon Blanc 2012 (Marlborough, New Zealand)
